

# Ziptrak Patio Blinds

---

**Why should I choose Ziptrak?** Ziptrak is the most user friendly blind on the market, by simply lifting the bottom bar the blind rolls itself away. Ziptrak can even be operated with a pull stick if your blind is mounted in a high area or if you have mobility issues preventing you from reaching the floor. **Maximum height:** 3.13m

**Maximum width:** 5m (largely dependent on how windy your outdoor area is, we will provide advice on this when you talk to one of our team)

**Material:** Like all of our Patio Blind systems, they are available in Clear PVC or Outdoor 3000 mesh. Please pick up a factsheet about these fabrics for more information (and PTO for pictures).

**Side spline:** The connection between the side tracks and the fabric. The side spline does all the hard work for the blind, it glides up and down the tracks and it holds the wind back. Made from super tough Cordura it is available in 6 different colours: White, Cream, Beige, Light Grey, Dark Grey, Black. PTO to see a picture of the colour options.

**Where do they mount:** Ziptrak is unique in that it 100% mounts on each side of your gap, nothing screws into the top beam or the floor. Ziptrak blinds usually screw onto the inside faces of the posts on each side of your gap, but they can also use a channel to mount on the face of the posts.

**Hardware options:** Flashing or fully enclosed Pelmet box for the gap above the roller tube (PTO for pictures). Standard or heavy-duty roller tube and bottom bar depending on your blind size.

**Powder coating options:** Anything from the Dulux Range. Your channels, tracks, bottom bar, flashing or pelmet box and brackets will be powder coated. The roller tube is anodised silver and is hidden by the fabric. The plastic components, track guides, top stops etc. are only available in black.

**Lifespan:** Approximately 10 years. Like all things in life, this will largely depend on how you use them, how often you use them, how you look after them etc. The good news is all parts of Ziptrak blinds are independently replaceable – for example, if the main skin was starting to look a bit shabby then this can be replaced, which is significantly cheaper than replacing the whole blind.

**Wind rating:** Out of all of our systems this is the only one that has been tested in a wind tunnel!! It has a rating of 80kph before it must be retracted. If you regularly get winds at or above 80kph then I recommend looking into our Tension Patio Blinds.

**Warranty:** We do not have a formal warranty set up for our products, however if something goes wrong because of a faulty component or if we got something wrong in the manufacture/install process then we will sort it out for you!! There is no need to worry, we do not leave any of our customers hanging.

**Can you DIY Ziptrak installation?** Not really. They are pretty tricky to set up just right!! We do have installation instructions we can supply you if you live in a location we can't get to or if you are REALLY keen to give it a go, but we will not be held responsible if the blinds wear out sooner than expected due to improper installation.
